The Christian and 'Presents'

Concerning others, Christians should be present and be a present. Let me explain. Webster's defines "present" as: "being in view or at hand." The same resource also gives another definition of "present" as "something presented: gift." So concerning others, Christians should be present (in their company) and be a present (a blessing to their lives).
