Or a demonstration of a fantastic new product but you must buy it right away if you want the best value. Have you even been lured into one of those “free puppy” deals in the dollar store parking lot? You are quick to say, “Sign me up” and don’t think about our decision on a daily basis—whether it

Not only does this happen in worldly decisions but spiritual decisions. When Peter, Andrew, James, and John were all called to follow Jesus, they “struck” and “immediately” followed him (Mat. 4:18-22). What was the kind of commitment they were making? Did they understand the sufferings they would have to endure? They later speak of the great commitment and sacrifice in following Him. He said that He had no place to lay His head (8:20) and a man must forsake all that he has to follow Him (Luke 14:33). Furthermore, Jesus would speak of that His followers must endure by being persecuted (5:11) and hated because of Him (Mark 13:13).

We are not much different today. Following Jesus is a big decision and there are persecutions and trials involved (2 Tim. 3:12). Yet, it is wonderful when you make that decision very quickly and show themselves committed every step of the way—no matter what. Such as Peter, Andrew, James, and John. In spite of their weaknesses, they proved to be valuable servants of Christ to the end of their lives. They said, “Sign me up” and “I’ll do it!” There were no gimmicks, presents, or accolades. 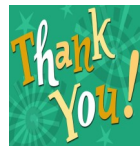
