The impact that the mother has on the child can and will have everlasting consequences (2 Timothy 3:15). The godly mother will pass on a genuine faith to her children just as Timothy's mother, Eunice did for him (2 Timothy 1:5). Here's a small sample of the mothers found in the Bible:

- Jochebed hid her son from harm for 3 months (Exodus 2:1-3)

- Bathsheba lost the son of her adultery (2 Samuel 12:15-18)
- Elizabeth's son prepared people for the Lord (Luke 1:13-17)
- Mary watched her Son be crucified for the world's sin (John 19:26)
